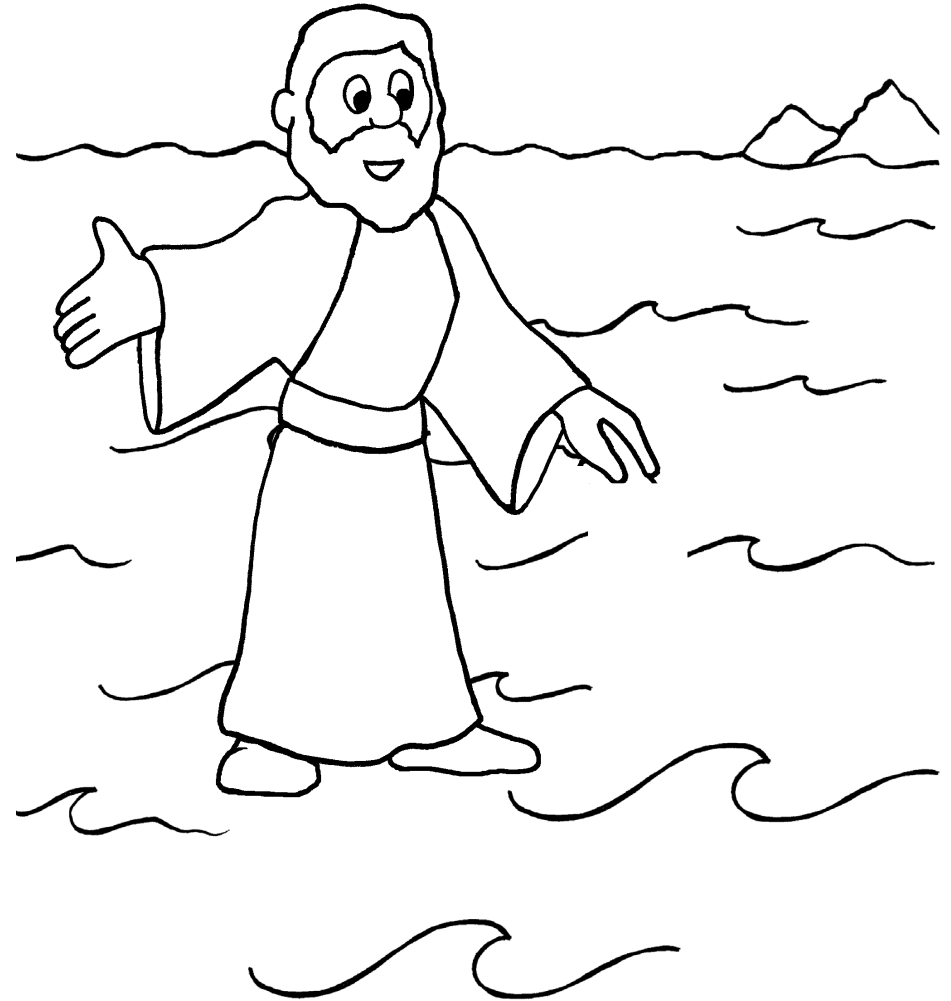

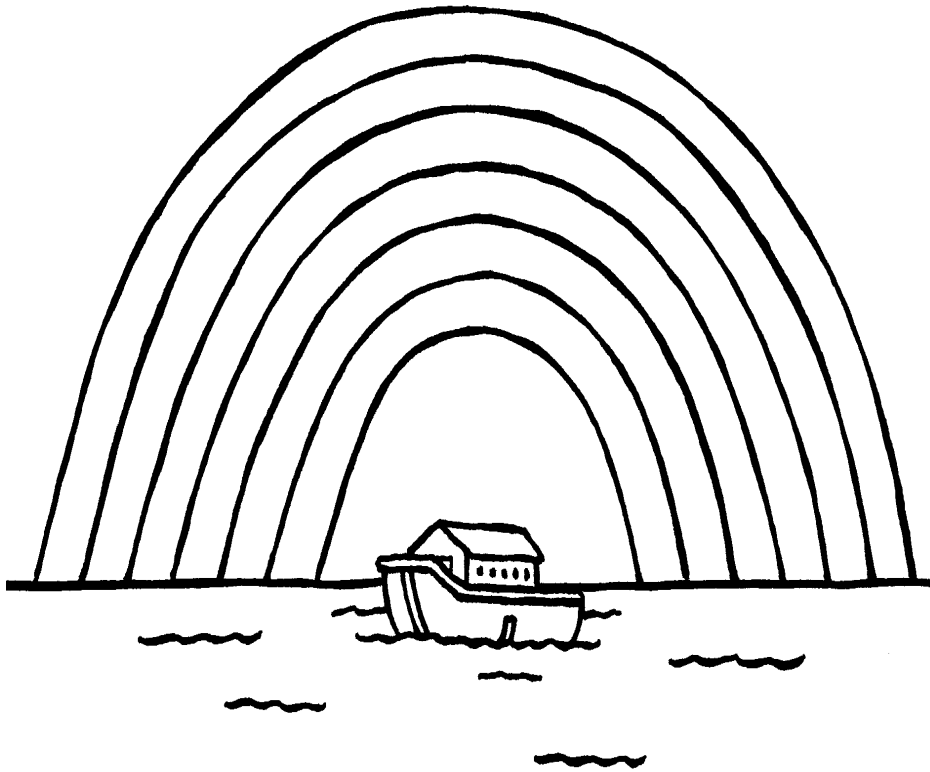


The disciples saw Jesus walk on water!
